Cindy Keller, **Health Commissioner**, things are moving smoother with the COVID vaccine. They are doing three clinics: second dose yesterday, Wednesday drive thru first vaccine and first and second does by appointment. She is still receiving two weekly calls from Lou Cooke. We are in line with the rest of the state. One vial arrived broken, she informed the state. The state is matching second dose with first dose. Names are attached for the second dose. They are now scheduling 50 per hour at the drive thru. They are signing a user agreement to schedule on-line. Will send a text alert and email. Will save them time. Hope to start using next week. The Governor relieved the Health Departments of giving schools vaccine. Schools will work thru the ESC. The ESC will be joining the Health Dept. on their Defense Team meetings. There is not enough vaccine to give all schools next week. The transition is going smoothly for the new DON and Deputy Health Commissioner. Commissioner Striker noted they did an awesome job at the first drive thru.

Chief Deputy Dennis Burns reporting for the **Sheriff**. Commissioner Striker thanked the Sheriff's staff for assisting at the vaccine drive thru, it all went smoothly. Weibels have been in to resolve no heat in the holding cells. Municipal Court is closed thru the remainder of the week. Some impact they can deal with. No issues noted with the Inauguration.
