MINUTES OF MAY 28th MEETING

All Commissioners were present. Staff recited the pledge at 9:00. Purchase orders and bills were reviewed and signed. Pending issues were discussed with the following resolutions approved and signed:

Sheriff Everhart and Chief Deputy Burns. Commissioner Rogers will be on vacation June 12 therefore Chief Deputy Burns will be the proxy at the Multi County Jail Meeting. Nixel: Marion County sends a lot of messages regarding telephone issues. Hardin County uses a free version with the Sheriff holding the privileges for emergencies. The new Drug Task Force Enforcement Grant was lower as expected. Hardin County is considered Level 2. It was noted the Sheriff is reallocating funds out of salaries. Sheriff noted he will have a shortfall and will discuss with the commissioners at a later date. Sheriff is dispatching every other 911 call to the Kenton Fire per Mayor Randy Manns letter of request. Sheriff will inform the commissioners regarding the levy for the fall ballot.

Kyle Camper, Dog Warden. Four dogs in the kennel this morning. Up 272 tags from last year. No rain water issues at the kennel. Water was laying but is now gone. The parking lot should be sealed again this fall. He recommends replacing the truck next year. It has 126,000 miles. He will start looking on state purchasing.

Jake Burgbacher, EMA/Loss Control. He is scheduling the annual safety walk thru the county buildings. Commissioners chose Cyber Security as the training module for 2019. Jake will make a choice for the second module. The current practice for inspections will remain in place. Appraisals start June 3 of all county owned buildings. He will be helping other counties with drills and emergencies during all the flooding in surrounding areas. While he was on vacation two issues came up: the EPA managed a livestock kill and the Kenton Fire Department handled the Wal-mart "terrorist" attack. He has already taken 13 classes for his EMA position and has many more to complete. The Emergency Plan is in process of being updated with the assistance of the 911 Communications Director. He documented the storm in Ridgeway/Mt. Victory area last week as well as the storm that went thru last night. Roll call resulted as follows:
