Commissioners and Clerk attended the Roundhead Waters Road Vacation Petition Viewing.

Steve Gossard, Veterans Service Officer, discussed a compensation increase request due to more training. ORC 5901.04 gives commissioners authority to give additional compensation. Was one conference per year and on-line training. Now they have to attend two out of three conferences and four on-line trainings as required. Like sized counties average VSC monthly compensation is \$409.75 for the five members. Average now is \$320.00 for Hardin County board members. Four out of seven counties are above \$490. Average compensation is 11.40%. Steve proposes to raise regular pay to \$430 VSO members, Secretary, \$440 Vice President, and President \$460. To take effect when new board member is appointed and/or an existing member is reappointed. Officer compensation would be implemented in 2022 after new officers are elected.
