MINUTES OF AUGUST 8th MEETING

All Commissioners were present. Staff recited the pledge at 9:00. Purchase orders and bills were reviewed and signed. Pending issues were discussed with the following resolutions approved and signed:

John Folk, **Job & Family Services**, gave the July monthly report. Unemployment up to 4.6%. Per diem cost (\$1452.37) are up and staff is reviewing cases for Kinship care placement. Most are due to the drug issues. With the passed state budget, cost for the non IV-E has been doubled. Additional programs are to be made available to allow for training to reunify families. On the job training contracts are starting to take off. JFS pays a portion of the wages for a certain period of time. Two companies are currently taking advantage of this program. Sept. 20 is scheduled for the annual Employee Appreciation cook-out. A position description will be presented to the full Family & Children First Council for Service Coordinator.

Judge Barrett noted the Adult Parole Authority relationship with the county has been up and down. Now Hardin County is losing the APA staff (2). Because Hardin County has both, we must reduce our APA and use Community Corrections more. They provide post release control supervision. Hardin County will continue to receive some funding during this biennium/contract period only. Judge Barrett is advertising for a new Corrections Officer.
